Dear friends

During 2022, we were finally able to resume the rhythm of events, marked as always by the sense and conviviality so characteristic of our network. 2022 was also marked by innovative projects, such as <a href="the-Paper on Biodiversity">this is an important production of knowledge, in a format that we had not tried before, and which reflects the commitment of HEC Alumni to impact issues in the broadest sense. Finally, 2022 was marked by an ever greater alignment with the school around its new President Jean-Paul Agon (H.78), Eloic Peyrache and his teams, and with the HEC Foundation. Our common vision and values, our shared raison d'être, make it possible to carry out joint projects such as the creation of an HEC House in London, which will open in the spring of 2023, or projects relating to our commitments to the challenges of ecological transition. In terms of academic recognition, the school remains at the top of the rankings despite a very competitive context: for the fourth year in a row, HEC was ranked No.1 in the Financial Times' 2022 ranking of the best European business schools. This is a fine demonstration of the quality of its faculty, its teaching staff and its courses, as well as the relevance of its selectivity, all programs included.

On a more personal note, my HEC class celebrated its 15th anniversary this year and it was an opportunity for me to reconnect with my classmates during a friendly reunion on campus.

I will end by looking ahead to 2023, which promises to be rich in opportunities and meetings. I invite you to consult the program which demonstrates the density of the HEC alumni network's activity. This was a great opportunity to confirm our ambition to mobilize economic actors, public decision-makers and civil society around the crucial issue of biodiversity. This White Paper, written by a team of students and young graduates from HEC Paris, Julie Christiaen (H.21), Théo Maret (H.23), Adam Melki (H.21), Eliette Verdier (H.20) and Julia Girard (H.20) under the direction of Christine Rodwell (H.92), and David Vaillant (H.98), was previously presented to the French Ambassador for the Environment, Sylvie Lemmet (H.81), in preparation for the COP15.
