HEC MBA Giving Month 2022

In October, the 3rd edition of HEC MBA Giving Month took place, a month-long collective mobilization to support HEC Paris' scholarship program for MBA students. More than 200 generous MBA donors from 38 countries and 50 different graduating classes raised €136,000 (+64% compared to the previous edition) which will allow the financing of 9 scholarships. A plaque bearing the name of each donor will be placed in the MBA building on campus, and a space will be dedicated to the MBA 2020 class for one year as it had the most donors for this 2022 edition.
