Dear Alumni.

This academic year marks the implementation of the revised Grande Ecole Program curriculum that we announced before the summer, and which I had the honor of orchestrating with the help of the entire faculty and various HEC teams and communities. The reform addresses the challenges of ecological, social and technological transition, and has already been very well received by our young students during this first month...

With a resolutely multi-disciplinary program, at the crossroads of management sciences, social sciences and data sciences, our aim is to train our students around three main challenges:

- around three main challenges:

  1 Mastering the major challenges facing societies and organizations, such as overcoming planetary limits, societal transformations, geopolitical conflicts and AI, based on a systemic approach open to all types of knowledge, and a critical middet.
- 2 The acquisition of multi-disciplinary knowledge in management and behavioral sciences, for an in-depth understanding of how organizations, society and its players function:
- 3 Going beyond the critical approach with the constant ambition to provide answers to the challenges of our time, in an entrepreneurial and responsible, solutions-oriented approach.

To achieve this, we have reorganized the entire curriculum, placing the first year under the banner of openness to social sciences and different types of knowledge, and a strong confrontation with the realities of the field through a course with civic involvement in associations and a field placement in a company. The second year will focus on management sciences, a course in data science, in-depth work on skills (negotiation, crisis management, communication, etc.) and the development of an entrepreneurial spirit.

So this is the start of a wonderful adventure that is mobilizing all our teams to continually improve the student experience, both academically and extra-academically, with careers and student life teams more dedicated than ever.

Finally, while the scope of our mission calls for humility and modesty, we are proud that the efforts of all HEC teams have been rewarded with great news: the MiM Grande Ecole program has been ranked 1st worldwide in the Financial Times 2023 rankings. This is recognition of the excellence of the HEC degree, and also a reason for us all to continue to surpass ourselves in the service of our community.
