#Inter, HEC Transition's 2024 hashtag for 2024

The Green Economy Club became the HEC Transition Club in 2022. The handover earlier this year between Adam Melki (H.21) and Charlotte Lambert (H.20) to co-chair the club with Antoine Rabain (M.06) was an opportunity to redefine our impact strategy around the club's 3 key stakeholders:

- The School, by contributing to the advancement of its transition via its roadmap, which includes the transformation of its curriculum and a higher visibility for careers with an impact; for this, we are working in close coordination with François Collin (H.87), the School's Chief Sustainability Officer, the S&O centre, HEC Talents, the SASI Master and its new academic director François Gemenne, as well as with HEC Paris' Executive Committee.
- Alumni, by creating a community committed to our 2024 projects. Among the 3,000 members of the Club, 500 collaborate in an agile way via Slack and Whatsapp, organising conferences, collaborative workshops, sustainable aperitifs and Climate or Biodiversity Fresks for all alumni, and by continually looking for new ways to collaborate with other HEC Alumni clubs in France and around the world.
- The rest of the world: citizens, other schools, elected representatives, businesses, etc., in particular by influencing the public debate: after the publication of the White Paper on blodiversity, we are currently working with the School and the Food Business club on a project where we are helping to bring together a panel representing the agri-food industry in Europe to establish a dialoque between professionals and elected representatives.

In short, we welcome the strengthened dynamic around an #intercultural, #international and #intergenerational grouping that wants to open up more and more to #inter-club projects and projects with the School, such as HEC's recent large-scale mobilization during the ChangeNOW summit (see photos) and François Gemenne's conference on that occasion.

Don't hesitate to join us, starting by <u>becoming a member of the club</u> and <u>following our HEC Transition LinkedIn group</u> and then by contributing to our projects! Our monthly board meeting is held every 1st Monday of the month, and during the last half-hour we systematically open a slot to all new members who would like to propose an initiative around the transition ecosystem.
