HEC Paris in Partnership with Yale School of Management

In early January, HEC Paris announced a groundbreaking collaboration with <u>Yale</u> <u>School of Management</u> for a transformative double degree program! This partnership will give candidates the opportunity to earn two master's degrees in two years — an <u>MBA at HEC Paris</u>, followed by a Master of Advanced Management degree at the Yale School of Management. <u>The new dual-degree program</u>, which was launched this month, allows candidates with 4 to 5 years of work experience to earn a 14-month MBA from
