We would like to honor our esteemed faculty, who have distinguished themselves with a record number of publications in leading scientific journals. They have also spearheaded the creation of new research centers, such as the Impact Company Lab and the Impact Finance Center. Additionally, we are proud to announce the Hi! Paris Center's recognition as a global research cluster in AI, accompanied by a record-breaking grant. Our heartfelt thanks to all our professors for their dedication, which allows us to offer an exceptional educational experience to our students and to promote the HEC brand

In the realm of teaching, we have made two significant advancements. First, we implemented the new Grande École curriculum, focusing on ecological, social, and technological transitions. Second, we established an international Bachelor's degree of excellence, reinforcing our ambition to build bridges within Furnoe

Furthermore, our school has demonstrated its mission to impact the greater good through the efforts of its institutes: Hi! Paris in AI, S&O on sustainability, and IEI on entrepreneurship and innovation. We have also intensified our commitment to social mobility, both in France and internationally. Our accomplishments include supporting 542 start-ups, with 21% of French unicorns founded by HEC students. We mourned the loss of our iconic Blondeau Amphitheatre to a fire, but we also celebrated the exceptional athletic achievements of our students in the beloved team sports on our campus.

The strength of our collective spirit is what stands out for me as we conclude this year marked by unprecedented international tensions. In the face of these challenges, our community has remained united, continually building bridges and fostering dialogue to bring people together in an increasingly polarized world. This is the message I conveyed at our graduation ceremony in June, and I hope to continue to champion it in the years to come, supported by the immense capacity for action and commitment that defines our community of 80.000 students and alumni worldwide.

I extend my heartfelt thanks to all the teams at the School, the Association, and the Foundation, as well as to all of you for your daily commitment to enhancing HEC's impact. I look forward to seeing you on November 26 in Paris to celebrate the conclusion of the Impact Tomorrow campaign, to which so many of you have contributed.

HEC Paris Awarded the Sustainable Development & Corporate Social Responsibility label

HEC Paris has been awarded the SD&RS label for higher education and research. This distinction recognizes the efforts made by the school in terms of sustainable development and social responsibility, and applies to all its activities. The label was awarded after a rigorous audit and in-depth examination of the HEC Paris application which was structured around five areas: Strategy and governance, training and teaching, research and innovation, environmental management, and social policy.


