Initiative of the Month

Our Clubs Contribute to Making Europe's Ecological Transition in Agriculture a Success

In keeping with its IMPACT mission, HEC Paris and the HEC Alumni Agri-Food, Transition and Entrepreneurs clubs joined forces with Pascal Canfin, Chairman of the European Parliament's Environment Committee, to bring together all the players in the agro-agri value chain to discuss the #Greendeal 2 guidelines. The aim was to learn from the realities on the ground about the difficulties experienced and to enable public policies for transition to work more effectively. In all, more than 40 entrepreneurs, farmers, sector managers, researchers, experts, academics and industrialists met in workshops to discuss 2 transition issues: the possible extension of carbon emission quotas to the agri-food sector and the financial tools for reducing the risks associated with the food transition.
