We are delighted to announce that the 2nd Business Leaders Lab barometer was launched on 20 March. This new survey focuses on the issue of **job satisfaction** and you can contribute to this research project by completing the short survey which was sent to you by email.

What is the HEC Business Leaders Lab?

The Business Leaders Lab was created in 2022 by HEC and the HEC Alumni association. Its aim is to identify the opinions and attitudes of HEC graduates to the major challenges of our time (changes in capitalism and work, climate change, etc.). The results of the surveys are used to improve the School's teaching and to formulate recommendations for companies and public policy while strengthening the links between the alumni community and research at HEC on these issues.

Why is job satisfaction at the heart of the next barometer?

In 2023, the first barometer provided a global overview of Alumni aspirations. One result struck us in particular: our alumni community stands out for its level of professional and personal satisfaction that far exceeds national averages. There are many studies on job satisfaction, but the views of managers, entrepreneurs and highly qualified employees on the sources of this satisfaction have not been analysed. That's why we hope that many of you will take part in this study. As with the first barometer, you'll be the first to know the results, and we'll be sharing your ideas for improving job satisfaction with the community. The surveys are, of course, anonymous and comply scrupulously with GDPR.
