For nearly 20 years, it has been my privilege to organize the L'Heure H series, a platform for cross-disciplinary discussions designed to shed light on the transformations shaping our world today. The series was born from an inspiring encounter with Matthieu Ricard, who shared his uplifting philosophy on happiness and altruism during an engaging session that drew a full house. Since then, these evening events have become a regular feature.

Each year, L'Heure H offers 5 to 6 events, attracting between 100 and 200 participants, featuring an hour-long keynote followed by a rich Q&A session. The high-level speakers—leaders in fields such as philosophy, economics, science, social issues, and geopolitics—deliver their insights solo, uninterrupted by the noise of debates or distractions. I'm pleased to have hosted nearly 100 distinguished speakers.

I can humbly say that participants consistently leave these events feeling enriched by the thoughtful exchanges. Personally, it is a true pleasure to organize these gatherings and to work closely with the HEC Alumni team. Looking ahead, on November 18th, we are excited to welcome Aurélie Jean, one of France's leading experts on artificial intelligence and algorithms. She will discuss her latest book, The Code Has Changed: Love and Sexuality in the Age of Algorithms. This promises to be a fascinating, perhaps even provocative, dive into the still mysterious world of AI and algorithms, a topic that continues to evolve.
